He is a well-known commentator of international political life and he wrote numerous pieces for The Financial Times and Les Echos. His book on *La Géopolitique de l'émotion : comment les cultures de peur, d'humiliation et d'espoir façonnent le monde* (2008) has been translated in 26 languages. His autobiography, *Un Juif improbable* (2011) is a personal testimony on the history of the XXth century. His latest book *La géopolitique des series ou le triomphe de la peur* (2016) will be published in a Dutch translation at the occasion of the granting of the Spinoza Award 2018.
